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## Karlheinz Weinberger Makes Us Thirsty for Summer Fun

Shot on the coasts and islands of Italy and across the sea into Morocco, the portraits capture the sailors, fisherman, beach bums, dockworkers, and the various handsome, muscular men that Weinberger encountered as while working his way through this string of coves and ports, immortalizing a moment in time when living and posing were two wholly separate enterprises.
